MONETA enables deposits into ATMs also via cards in watches and mobile phones

Prague, 8 January 2024

It is now much easier to deposit cash into Moneta's deposit ATM machines. All you need is a mobile phone and a scan of your payment card inside. So-called tokenised cards, which are loaded in mobile devices in services such as Apple pay, Google Pay or Garmin Pay, will also allow their owners to find out the balance in their bank account.

"Until now, only cash withdrawals have been possible within Moneta's ATM network via mobile phones or watches and the payment cards loaded on them. We are now extending this service to deposit funds from our deposit machines. We are thus bringing our clients further simplification of their banking transactions," said Zuzana Filipová, spokesperson of the MONETA Group, in this context.

The newly introduced service does not allow cash deposits into foreign currency and child accounts. For newly tokenised cards, ATM deposits are available the day after tokenisation (uploading the card to a mobile device or adding it to the virtual wallet of a given mobile phone or smartwatch).
